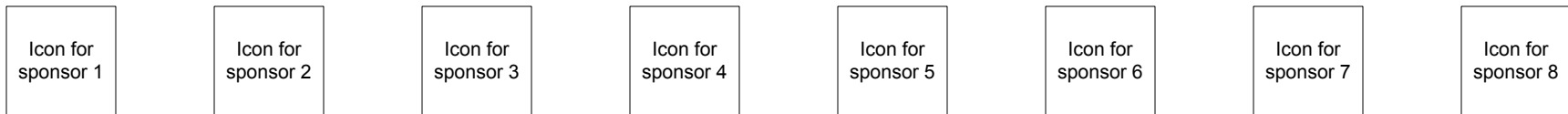

## Getting There

### By Air

#### To Madrid and Malaga:

Virgin Express  
offers cheap ways of flying to Madrid from several European cities.  
Expedia.com  
is a good site for international travel information.

#### From Madrid/Barcelona to Seville:

Ticket prices are around 100 euros.  
Travel time is approximately 1 hour from Madrid, 1h 30 min from Barcelona  
Iberia  
Spanair

#### By train from Madrid:

high-speed line (AVE): [RENFE](#)  
You can book your tickets directly at the [RENFE web page](#).  
Madrid - Seville: 52,50 euro (off peak) / 62 euro (normal) (both tourist class)  
Discounts for return (20%), youth card (25%) and flight connections are available (25%), but may not be accumulated.  
If you arrive more than 5 minutes later than the scheduled time, you will be entitled to your money back as long as the delay is due to High-Speed RENFE.  
Travel time: 2h 15 min aprox.

#### By train from Malaga:

#### By bus from Madrid:

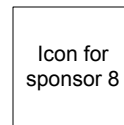
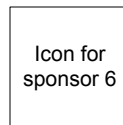
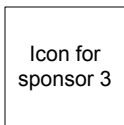

This is the most economic way to go to Sevilla from Madrid. The ticket price is 24 euros.  
SociBus buses are equipped with A/C, TV, VCR, WC, captain chairs (reclinable seats with feet rest and food tray), individual sound system (with headphones) to hear TV and various audio channels.
